RESHORING IS REALITY!

Many in manufacturing doubt what they hear about reshoring, but reshoring is reality! Recently, some of the largest publicly traded manufacturers have reshored work to the U.S., according to the Reshoring Initiative. For example, Ford Motor Co. shifted 3,250 jobs from Mexico to Ohio and Michigan for work on the F650 and F-750 truck models, the Fusion midsize model and its EcoBoost engine.

2014 was an active year for reshoring. General Electric and Caterpillar each brought 1,900 jobs back from overseas, according to the report from the Reshoring Initiative, led by Harry Moser, founder of the Initiative. General Electric reshored production of several appliance models including its hybrid hot water heaters, and a high-end refrigerator with bottom drawer freezer that used to be manufactured in Mexico was brought back to be made at GE's Appliance Park in Louisville, KY.

General Motors also brought jobs from Mexico back to the U.S., reshoring 1,800 positions making gasoline engines and the Cadillac SRX model to Tennessee.

Other reshoring companies that were noted by the Reshoring Initiative's report were Flextronics, and hair products (hair irons, blow dryers, and hair-care products) company Farouk Systems. Farouk Systems began reshoring several years ago from China to Texas where its headquarters are, due to extensive theft of the company's intellectual property and large numbers of counterfeit products being shipped from China.
